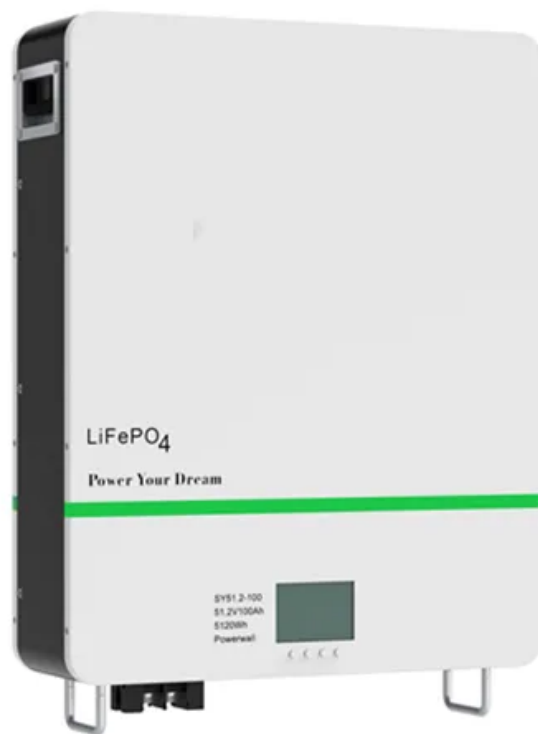


# **The reason why Bosnia and Herzegovina does not use base station communication**

On October 9, 1992, the Security Council passed Resolution 781, establishing a no-fly zone over Bosnia-Herzegovina. What did NATO do in Bosnia & Herzegovina?

The NATO intervention in Bosnia and Herzegovina was a series of actions undertaken by NATO whose stated aim was to establish long-term peace during and after the Bosnian War.

When did NATO start monitoring Bosnia and Herzegovina?

A month later, in July 1992, NATO began monitoring operations in the Adriatic in support of UNSCR 713 and 757 imposing an arms embargo and sanctions in the former Yugoslavia. By October 1992, NATO AWACS surveillance aircraft were monitoring operations in support of UNSCR 781, imposing a no-fly zone over Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Will Bosnia and Herzegovina join NATO by 2011?

Then in November 2008, a joint announcement from the Defence Minister and the NATO Mission Office in Sarajevo suggested that Bosnia and Herzegovina could join NATO by 2011 if the defense reforms made until then were continued.

What happened to Bosnia and Herzegovina's defence system?



In March 2004, a state-level defence minister brought the country's two separate armies under a single command structure. NATO's military headquarters in Sarajevo has a leadership role in the Defence Reform Commission and is continuing to work on defence reform in Bosnia and Herzegovina. Arresting war crimes suspects.

Will Bosnia and Herzegovina get a map?

While the country did not receive a MAP at the April 2009 summit in Strasbourg-Kehl, Stuart Jones, an official of the US State Department, said on a September 2009 visit to Bosnia and Herzegovina that NATO was going to look at the possibilities for them to receive one in a December 2009 summit, repeating strong US support for the possibility.

Should Bosnia and Herzegovina have a single defence establishment?

A single defence establishment for Bosnia and Herzegovina is proposed with an appropriate and workable division of responsibilities between State and entity institutions. The Presidency would act collectively in exercising command and control of the Armed Forces of Bosnia and Herzegovina in peacetime, crises, and war.

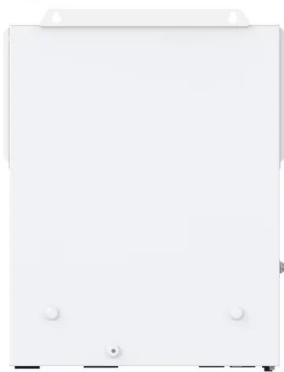
