

What are the base stations for mobile communications





Overview

In communications, a base station is a communications station installed at a fixed location and used to communicate as part of one of the following:

- a system, or;
- a system such as or .

A base station, also known as a cell site or cell tower, is used for wireless communication. It is a fixed location equipped with antennas and other equipment that receives and transmits radio signals to and from mobile devices, such as smartphones, tablets, and other wireless devices. What is a base station in a cellular telephone network?

Base stations in cellular telephone networks are more commonly referred to as cell towers. Each cellphone connects to the cell tower, which in turn connects it to the wired public switched telephone network (PSTN), the internet or to other cellphones within the cell.

Mobile communication base station is a form of radio station, which refers to a radio transceiver station that transmits information between mobile phone terminals through a mobile communication exchange center in a certain radio coverage area.
